Rail Overview

Massachusetts is home to vital passenger, freight, and commuter rail lines, as well as rail suppliers. Massachusetts has the 6th largest commuter rail system in the country.



Freight

12 freight railroads, including Class Is like CSX and short line railroads like Pan Am Railways, Providence & Worcester Railroad and Massachusetts Coastal Railroad, move more than 460,000 carloads of intermodal, petroleum, minerals, chemicals and other types of freight over 1,000 miles with 650 employees.



Commuter

MA is home to the **6th** busiest commuter rail system in the country. Commuter rail provides more than **32** million passenger trips each year on MBTA, which runs trains over **398** miles of track to **137** stations.

MBTA infrastructure is also critical to Amtrak, which runs Northeast Corridor trains over MBTA track.



Amtrak

MA has the Northeast Corridor, which runs Acela and regional trains. It also has 1 long distance train, the Lakeshore Limited, and 2 state supported Amtrak trains, including:

 million train riders are
 served at MA stations
 each year. Amtrak
 employs more than 700
 residents and spent more
 than \$108 million on
 goods and services in MA.



Suppliers

The rail supply industry contributes more than \$755 million to MA's GDP and supports more than 6,800 jobs, including 1,545 direct jobs in MA through companies like Progress Rail and Siemens Mobility.

Did you know?

It would have taken approximately **874,000** additional trucks to handle the **15.7** million tons of freight that originated in, terminated in, or moved through MA by rail in 2017.
